Dear Parent and Carers,

I am pleased to inform you that the Department for Education published guidance yesterday afternoon, confirming that Nursery classes in schools can remain open, during this period of national lockdown. Until this guidance was available, I have only kept our Nursery open to parents of critical workers and vulnerable children.

From Monday 11th January, our Nursery will be open to all children on our current register and parents can bring their children to attend their session already organised with Mrs Keefe. Our Nursery will continue to be run by Mrs Keefe and Mrs Morris. Timings of the day will also be the same as before Christmas. Morning sessions will start at 9am and finish at 12pm. Afternoon sessions will start at 12pm and finish at 3.15pm. If children are attending all day, they will start at 9am and finish at 3.15pm.

The drop-off and collection point for Nursery children will continue to be via the Nursery door. From Monday all children will need to wear school uniform.

Parents can order meals for their children again from the Farm Kitchen, for the week commencing 18th January.

We will continue to follow the same risk assessment as we did before Christmas. Nursery will be their own bubble and we will continue to follow all the necessary measures to make school as safe as we possibly can.
