We were meant to be in school **dressing as Stone Age people** and completing some activities. I would like to try do these online with you and if you could dress up too that would be amazing and bring a smile to everyone's faces? It would be brilliant if you were to **bring a pencil and paper to this meeting** and any red / brown art tools (crayons, felt tips, wax crayons, pastels or anything you wish to use) to do some historical art together. After the meeting, I will upload the project work for the week.
