Hot Meals from The Farm Kitchen

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am very pleased to inform you that we will be offering your child the option of a hot meal again from Monday 2nd November (the first day back after half term) and these are priced at just £2.40 each.

I have worked closely with the Farm Kitchen and we are able to provide hot meals to all of our children without changing our current arrangements at lunch time, as explained in our risk assessment. Children in Reception and Year 1, followed by children in Year 2 and Year 3 will continue to eat their lunch in the hall. Children in Nursery, Year 4, 5 and 6 will continue to eat their lunch in their classroom. Timings for eating and playing outside will also be the same as they have been since the beginning of September.

Menus are now live on The Farm Kitchen website. You can order meals for your child for the first two weeks back after half term up until 3pm on Tuesday 27th October – using your usual login details at <https://thefarmkitchen.com/>.

I'd like to remind you that all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM). It is fantastic that this continues to be offered and I hope that as many of you as possible will take advantage of this.

Pupils entitled to Free School Meals (FSM) are also entitled to a meal every day. If you think your child should be entitled to a FSM, please apply online through the Lincolnshire County Council website or alternatively contact Mrs Day in our school office and she will be able to support you to make an application.

The Farm Kitchen is based in Lincolnshire and provides delicious as well as nutritious schools meals, using locally sourced, quality ingredients. All meals meet the requirements of School Food Standards.
