Dear Parents and Carers,

I am pleased to announce that, from the week beginning Monday 25<sup>th</sup> May, we will be able to provide free school meal lunch boxes instead of vouchers. This is following government guidance on schools using their own food providers as the preferred option. Although free school meals are *not* being provided next week via the Edenred voucher system, we *are* providing lunches to our families through The Farm Kitchen.

A typical lunch box will contain:

- a loaf of bread
- 2 small jars of jam
- orange juice
- carrots
- 2 small cereal boxes
- 2 jacket potatoes
- 2 small packets of biscuits
- 2 bags of crisps
- a tin of tuna
- 2 sachets of mayonnaise
- 3 pieces of fruit
- a tin of soup
- UHT milk
- 2 cheese triangles

Please note, however, that the contents will vary from week to week.

For the week commencing Monday 25<sup>th</sup> May (Half Term), your free school meal lunch box will be available to collect on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> May between 10:30am and 3:00pm. These can be collected from the school main entrance area (near the office). Please adhere to social distancing rules – with no more than one person collecting their box at a time. When collecting your lunch box, they will need to be signed for. Slips to sign will be left on the table in the entrance area, with a box to place the slip in once signed.

For the week commencing Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June, we will continue to provide lunch boxes for pupils not in school. We will update you with further information regarding this as soon as possible.
