Dear Parents,

On Wednesday 12th February, I would like to take Year 3 to visit the *Back to Bear* site at Kenwick, Louth, in order to bring our Tribal Tales project to life. The visit will provide an exciting opportunity for the children to develop survival skills and understand how different life was in the Stone Age. Children will handle prehistoric objects, make fires using historical methods (in a controlled environment), construct spears and develop hunting skills.

We will be leaving school at 9:30am and we will be back by the usual school finishing time of 3:15pm.

Your child will need to come to school wearing warm clothing, as we will be outside all day. Layers are recommended along with gloves, a hat and a water proof jacket. It is important that children bring a pair of wellington boots with them in a separate bag (we are unable to get on the coach with muddy shoes).

Children will require a packed lunch and plenty to drink. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen or they can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch, you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.

The cost of the visit will be **£12.77** per child, which we are asking for as a voluntary contribution. Please make this payment via your ParentPay account (this will act as your permission for your child to attend the visit). If you have any problems with ParentPay, please speak with Mrs Day in the office Monday-Thursday.

Visits are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. Although contributions are voluntary, if we do not receive sufficient funding, the visit will unfortunately have to be cancelled. Governors have agreed that any pupil eligible for Pupil Premium will not need to contribute and the school will pay the contribution on their behalf.
