Dear Parents,

We are excited to inform you that on the week commencing the 30th September, our colleagues from Guadeloupe will be returning to our school. As part of this project, we have arranged for Year 4, 5 and our Guadeloupe visitors to go on a trip to the Farm Kitchen in Ewerby near Sleaford on Thursday 3rd October. We will leave school at 9.15am, straight after Year 4's class assembly, in order to reach the Farm Kitchen for 10:15am.

In the morning, we will split our time between Ewerby Reading Rooms and the Farm Kitchen. The day will include tomato planting, bread making, a farm talk, kitchen tour and having photographs taken with a tractor. The Farm Kitchen will also provide a free dinner and morning snack for every child so please inform your child's class teacher of any food allergies we need to be aware of. We will return to school in time for the end of the school day, dependent on traffic.

As the Farm Kitchen provide our school meals, the day itself is free. However in order to fund the cost of the bus, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £4.50. Please pay via Parent Pay no later than Friday 27th September. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. Although contributions are voluntary, if we do not receive sufficient funding, the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. Governors have agreed that any pupil eligible for pupil premium will not need to contribute and school will pay the contribution on their behalf.

The children will need to wear their normal school uniform however they may wish to wear comfortable footwear which they do not mind getting a little muddy (wellies and a spare plastic bag if it is raining). Please also make sure that your child brings along clothing which is suitable for the weather. As dinner and snack will be provided by the farm kitchen, children do not need a pack up but should bring along plenty to drink.
