Dear Parents/Carers,

On Monday 8th July, we would like to take Years 3 and 4 to Skegness beach as part of our project work with our partner school in Guadeloupe. We aim to leave school at 9am, spend the morning at the beach and will return during the afternoon at approximately 2:30pm. During the visit, the children will collect litter, spend time creating some beach themed artwork and have a play on the beach.

The children can wear their summer clothes and can bring a bucket and spade should they wish to. Please ensure that children are wearing sun cream and have a sunhat and plenty to drink. As this visit is taking place on a Monday, children will also need to bring a packed lunch which should be in a named bag or lunchbox. There will be an opportunity for children to buy an ice cream after lunch. If you would like your child to have an ice cream, please also provide up to £2 in a named envelope.

In order to fund the visit, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £3.80. This will cover the cost of the coach. Please pay via Parent Pay no later than Wednesday 3rd July. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. Although contributions are voluntary, if we do not receive sufficient funding the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. Governors have agreed that any pupil eligible for pupil premium will not need to contribute and school will pay the contribution on their behalf.

We are looking for some parent helpers for this trip. If you are available to come along and help, then please let the office staff know as soon as possible.
