Dear Parents,

To support their learning this term, we would like to take children in Reception and Nursery to Rand Farm Park for an action-packed day of 'Summer Fun'. The visit will take place on Thursday 13th June.

We will be leaving school at 9.00am and returning to school by approximately 3.10pm for normal collection time. Therefore, children will need to arrive at school by the usual time of 8.45am. Children will need to wear normal school uniform on this day. Please also ensure your child has a packed lunch and plenty to drink.

The cost of the visit has been subsidised by a kind contribution from the Friends of Grimoldby School (FrOGS) and therefore will cost £9.18 per child, which we are asking for as a voluntary contribution. Please make this payment by Friday 7th June via your ParentPay account (this will act as your permission for your child to attend the visit). If you have any problems with ParentPay, please speak with Mrs Day in the office Monday-Thursday.

Visits are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. Although contributions are voluntary, if we do not receive sufficient funding the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. Governors have agreed that any pupil eligible for pupil premium will not need to contribute and school will pay the contribution on their behalf.

As always, we would welcome any volunteers to help on the visit. If you are interested in helping, please let Mrs Day know in the office or come and see me on the playground at the end of the day. We will contact you nearer the time with more details.
