Dear Parents,

To support their learning this term, we would like to take children in Reception and Nursery to the Skegness Aquarium to see some of the amazing creatures that live there, have a guided tour of the Aquarium and take part in a pirate workshop! The visit will take place on Thursday 14th March.

We would like to invite all Nursery children to join us. If you feel your child would manage the whole experience and journey to Skegness you are welcome to swap sessions that week so that your child will attend all day on Thursday 14th March.

If you have decided that your child won't be joining us, there will unfortunately be no nursery session on that day as all adults will be visiting the Aquarium. If your child would usually be with us on the Thursday, please feel free to rearrange this session for some other time by talking to Mrs McDowall or Miss Mountain.

We will be leaving school at **9.00am** and returning to school by approximately **3.10pm**. Therefore, children will need to arrive at school by the usual time of 8.45am and be collected at 3.15pm. Children will need to wear normal school uniform on this day. Please also ensure your child has a packed lunch and plenty to drink.

The cost of the visit has been subsidised by a kind contribution from the Friends Of Grimoldby School (FrOGS) and therefore will cost £8.70 per child, which we are asking for as a voluntary contribution. Please make this payment by Monday 11th March via your ParentPay account (this will act as your permission for your child to attend the visit). If you have any problems with ParentPay, please speak with Mrs Day in the office Monday-Thursday.

Visits are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. Although contributions are voluntary, if we do not receive sufficient funding the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled. Governors have agreed that any pupil eligible for pupil premium will not need to contribute and school will pay the contribution on their behalf.

If you have any questions about the visit, or if you would rather have your child not attend the visit, please come and speak with me directly as soon as possible.
