Dear Parents and Carers,

On **Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May**, Year 2 will be visiting Lincoln Castle to bring our History learning about castles to life! The visit will provide an opportunity for the children to see for themselves how important a castle was in defending its occupants and what life was like for those who lived there. It will also enhance their understanding of our local history and why Lincoln was a good place to build a castle. The children will take part in three workshops; a tour of the castle and wall walk, Knight training and a banquet!

We will be leaving school promptly at **8:45am** and we aim to be back by **3:15pm**.

The cost of the trip will be **£20.00** per child, payable via ParentPay. This is to cover the cost of the coach, admission to the castle and the three workshops. We have been able to reduce the cost of this thanks to fundraising by FROGS, additional payment by school and sharing of the coach with another class. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. We know times are financially difficult for our families. If you would like help with the cost of this trip please do get in touch with us.

The children will need to wear their normal school uniform. Please make sure that they have a coat and wear comfortable footwear as there will be quite a bit of walking. Please also make sure that your child has a packed lunch and drink to take with them. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen, or they can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch, you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.
