### Driving near and past school

For the safety of all our children and families, we kindly ask that parents adhere strictly to the speed limits when driving near and past our school. The speed limit on Manby Middlegate leading up towards the school is 30mph, with an advisory speed limit of 20mph directly outside the school building on Tinkle Street. Many of our children walk or cycle to school each day so it is essential that everyone drives with care and follows these limits to keep our community safe.

Please also remember that the lay-by outside of school is reserved for buses and taxis and should not be used for dropping off children. In addition, we ask all parents to follow our one-way system for drop off and collection. Enter the main playground via the village hall car park and exit through the small gate along the side of the Year 6 classroom. We really appreciate your continued support in helping us keep everyone safe.

If you have moved house, have a new telephone number, or would like to change the safeguarding arrangements for who can collect your child, please do get in touch with our school office. It is so important we have the correct contact information and the correct medical information for your child (especially as this may change as your child becomes older).
