Below are several tasks to choose from to complete at home over this term in your scrapbook. You can complete them in any order and choose to do as many as you wish. Please write in the date when you complete them.

<p>Ready For Reading!</p> <p>Date:</p>	<p>Choose an animal story to read. Examples include <i>The Tiger Who Came to Tea</i> by Judith Kerr, <i>The Hare and the Tortoise</i> by Brian Wildsmith or <i>How to Hide a Lion</i> by Helen Stephens. Draw a picture of your favourite event in the story. Write a few sentences beneath your picture to explain what is happening.</p> 
<p>Welly Walk</p> <p>Date:</p>	<p>Look out onto your street, explore your garden and take a walk in your neighbourhood to look for plants and animals. Record the plants and animals that you see in a table. Use the data you have collected to find out which type of plant and animal was the most and least common.</p> 
<p>Precious Pets</p> <p>Date:</p>	<p>Choose a pet that you would like to investigate. Research how to look after the pet. Record your findings, including what pet you have chosen, what it eats, where it should live and any special things this pet needs.</p> 
<p>Habitat Hunting</p> <p>Date:</p>	<p>Look at pictures of wild animals. Choose your favourite and then use information books and the internet to find out where in the world they live, what they eat and their habitat.</p> 
<p>Creativity!</p> <p>Date:</p>	<p>In Term 5, our key value is creativity. Choose your favourite animal and make an animal collage using different paper. Try to use different colours, patterns and textures.</p> 
<p>You Choose!</p> <p>Date:</p>	<p>We've been learning lots of things across the Summer term, choose something that has inspired and interested you. Create a piece of home learning in whichever way you would like. You could create a piece of writing, make a model or create a drawing... the possibilities are endless.</p>
