At Grimoldby Primary School, we value the safety and well-being of all our pupils. As part of our commitment to providing a secure and supportive learning environment, we have established this policy regarding photography and videos at school events. This policy outlines our guidelines and expectations to ensure the protection and privacy of all our students, particularly those who, for legal reasons, cannot be shared online.

Photography by the School

When parents complete the school's admission process, they complete our 'GDPR Images/Videos Consent' online form so that the school may take photographs, place pictures on the school website, in displays in school, in the media and on the school's social media accounts. Requests by parents to not grant this permission, however, will be fully respected by the school.

Photography by Parents & Visitors

Unless specific permission is given by a senior member of staff, and it is used in the presence of an agreed member of staff, the use of cameras, video cameras, mobile phone cameras or any other image capturing device on the school premises during school hours or when children are present by parents/carers, visitors or contractors is not permitted.

Parents/Carers are asked **not** to take photographs and recordings of their child during school events such as assemblies (for example our annual 'leavers assembly') and on events such as Sports Day.

Photography by Pupils

Pupils do not take cameras or other photographic devices on school trips. On some residential trips, the school will take responsibility for producing pictures which parents can access online.

Any phones /photographic devices brought into school by children in Key Stage 2 must be left in the agreed location in the classroom at the start of the day and retrieved at the end of the day.
