Dear Parents,

As part of the KS2 Science Curriculum, we have arranged for children in Years 5 and 6 to go to the Magna Science Adventure in Rotherham on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July. We will leave school at 8am in order to reach Rotherham for 10:00am, and school will be open from 7.50am. Please make sure that your child is in school for this earlier time. Due to the car park being inaccessible at this time, children should walk down the path next to Miss Groves' office and enter through the small gate next to Year 6.

Throughout the day, we will spend time exploring the centre, as well as having a planetarium experience and will return to school for 4:15pm, dependent on traffic.

The cost of the trip will be £16.28 payable via ParentPay (please note that this cost is slightly lower than the Year 6 cost as Y5 have some funding generously given by FROGs remaining, which Year 6 have already used on a previous trip). This is to cover the cost of the coach and admission. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. We know times are financially difficult for our families. If you would like help with the cost of this trip, please do get in touch with us.

The children will need to wear their normal school uniform. Please also make sure that your child has a packed lunch and drink to take with them. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen or they can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch, you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.
