

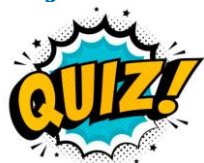
Year 4 Home Learning Tasks Term 3 and 4

The quiz can include any of the following:

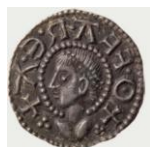
- Anglo-Saxon Britain.
