The Working Together Team (WTT) in Lincolnshire empowers mainstream schools, colleges, and families to better support autistic children and young people (ages 4-19) with social communication differences by providing specialist training, direct support, and resources, focusing on building capacity, advocating best practices, and improving inclusion through collaborative strategies and evidence-based approaches. The WTT have recently released various pre-recorded training sessions for parents.

These sessions include:

- Exploring social communication differences (parents)
- Anxiety (School age pupils)
- Supporting a profile of demand avoidance in autism (inc. PDA)
- Executive functioning
- Autism and Understanding emotions.
- Developing social knowledge (inc. Using Social Stories and Comic Strip Conversations)
