Dear Parents,

On Friday 17th July, I would like to take Year 3 to visit Uncle Henry's Farm. The visit will provide an opportunity for the children to learn more about the operations of a farm and where our food comes from. From this visit, we will consolidate our Design and Technology learning as well as our Science knowledge. We will be consolidating our knowledge of nutrients before cooking a meal using locally sourced foods and completing an investigation into the conditions that foods need to grow.

We will be leaving school at 9:00am and we will be back by 3:15pm, and your child will need to come to school wearing their school uniform.

Children will require a packed lunch with a drink. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen, or your child can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.

The cost of the visit will be £15.82 per child - this includes the visit and the cost of the coach.

Please make this payment via your ParentPay account. If you have any problems with ParentPay, please speak with Miss Grove in the office. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support.
