YEAR 6 HOMEWORK – LEARNING BY QUESTIONS

Dear Parents and Carers,



Your child may have come home and spoken about completing homework on **Learning by Questions (LBQ)**. This is a website that we bought into school last year to support learning both at home and in school. From this week, Year 6 will be completing their homework using **Learning by Questions**. This is an electronic platform that allows children to complete short, interactive tasks from home. We hope this will prepare children for next year as most homework is completed electronically in secondary settings.

Each child will find their **Independent Learning Code in their Reading Record**, which they will need to log in to the LBQ website. The website can be accessed through a phone, tablet or computer. Homework will be set **every Friday** and is due in by the following Friday morning.

Tasks will usually take no longer than **30 minutes per week**. These activities are designed to support and extend the learning happening in class. As children work through the questions, LBQ provides instant feedback to help them learn from any mistakes. If your child gets an answer wrong, please remind them to read the **feedback** carefully before trying again.

One of the great benefits of Learning by Questions is that it allows us, as teachers, to see exactly how your child is doing at home. We can tell how many attempts they needed, which questions they found tricky, and where we can provide extra support. It also helps to challenge children by moving them on to more complex questions once they are confident with earlier ones.

If you experience any problems logging in or if your child is struggling with any of the concepts, please do let us know so that we can help.
