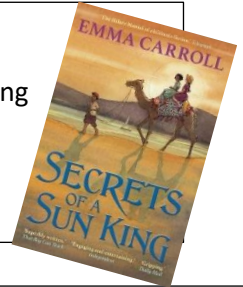

English

- Use and correctly punctuate direct speech.

Maths

Science - Forces

RE – Christianity:

Key Question: Is the Christmas story true?

- Understand how there might be different versions of events which are all true to some extent and to some people.
- Retell a version of the Christmas story from the Bible.
- Compare versions of the Christmas story from the Bible.
- Start to explain what a Christian might believe is true from the Christmas Story.
- Explain how 'true' could mean different things to different people, and how stories can be 'true' in different ways.
- Explain how people can see truths in stories which may not be completely true.

PSHE – Celebrating difference.

- Understand that cultural differences sometimes cause conflict.
- Understand what racism is.
- Understand how rumour-spreading and name-calling can be bullying behaviours.
- Explain the difference between direct and indirect types of bullying.
- Compare my life with people in the developing world.
- Understand a different culture from my own.

French – in the classroom.

- Recognise, recall and spell twelve different classroom items with their indefinite articles/ determiners.
- Be able to answer the question 'What is in your pencil case?'
- Revise possessive adjectives and apply to classroom items.
- Revise negative structures in order to say what they do not have in their pencil cases.

Computing – online safety

- Understand how apps can access personal information and how to alter permissions.
- Be aware of the positive and negative aspects of online communication.
- Understand how online information can be used to form judgements.
- Discover ways to overcome bullying online.
- Understand how technology can affect health and wellbeing.
