Dear Parents and Carers,

On Thursday 27th November 2025, Year 1 will be visiting *The Deep* in Hull to take part in the *Sam's Seagrass Safari* workshop. During this engaging session, children will explore the geography of Spurn Point using maps and aerial photos, learn about the seagrass plant life cycle, and take part in fieldwork to identify animals in the habitat. They'll also discover how conservation helps protect local environments. There will also be time to explore other areas of the aquarium to complement our geography and science learning. Please ensure your child is at school for **8:15am** as we will be leaving school promptly at **8:30am** and aim to be back by **3:10pm**.

The cost of the trip will be **£18.00** per child, payable via ParentPay. We have been able to reduce the cost of this thanks to fundraising by FRoGS. This payment covers the cost of the coach and The Deep's workshop. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. We know times are financially difficult for our families. If you would like help with the cost of this trip please do get in touch with us.

The children will need to wear their normal school uniform. Please make sure that they have their coat and are wearing comfortable footwear. Please also make sure that your child has a **packed lunch and drink** to take with them. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen, or they can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch, you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.
