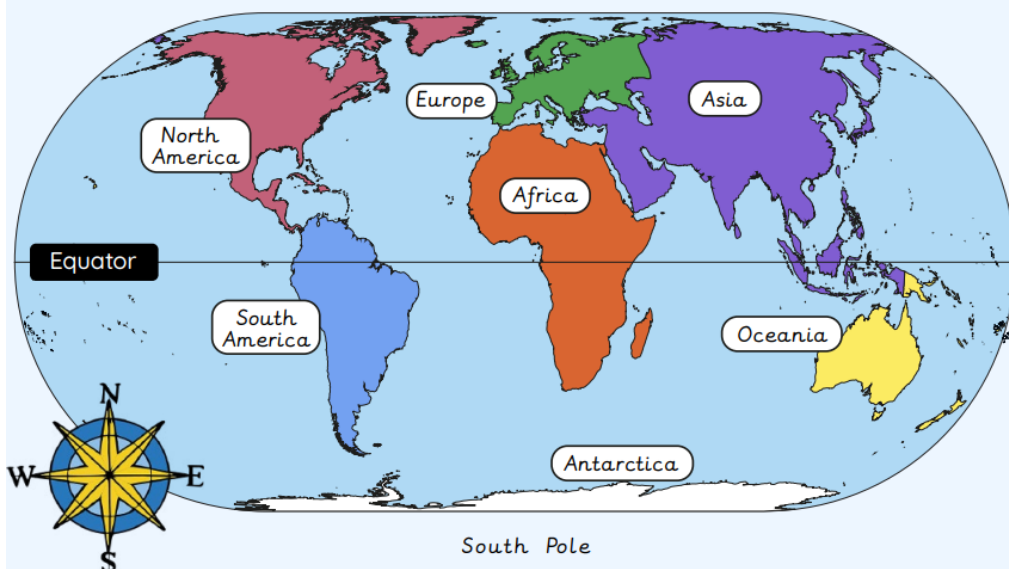
To locate the North and South Poles.

North Pole



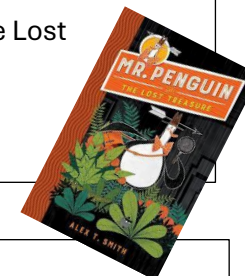

- Use capital letters and full stops accurately.
- Look at the features of a narrative.
- Write character and setting descriptions.
- Understand and use adjectives and conjunctions.
- Re-read our writing to check that it makes sense.
- Form all lower case and capital letters correctly, using lead-in lines.
- Apply our phonics knowledge to reading and spelling.
- Read text fluently and with appropriate intonation.
- To use prediction skills on the basis of what is said and done in a text.
- To retrieve information from a text.
- To begin to make simple inferences from a text.

Maths

- Recognise numbers to 100, being able to group into tens.
- Learn how to use a place value chart and partition numbers to 100.
- Use a number line to place numbers and estimate numbers.
- Count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.
- Learn the number bonds to 10 and then 100 and their related facts.
- Add and subtract 1s and 10s.
- Add three numbers.
- Add and subtract a 1-digit number from a 2-digit number, crossing the tens.



Science - Animals Including Humans

- Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

Art – Drawing

- To understand that artists find inspiration for artwork from their environment.
- To explore my environment and collect things that inspire me.
- To explore different drawing exercises to record the things you have collected.

D&T - Structures: Baby Bear's Chair.

- To explore the concept and features of structures and the stability of different shapes.
- To understand that the shape of the structure affects its strength.

History

- What do you think the Wright brothers did to make them famous?
- How did the Wright brothers manage to be the first to launch a man powered flight?
- How do we possibly know about their first successful flight, when it happened over 100 years ago now?

GYMNASTICS – Body Management

- To know and use small and large body parts.
- To perform a learnt sequence.
- To link 3 static positions.
- To perform and evaluate an original sequence.

GAMES: Object Control

- To roll and receive with control.
- To use equipment to send and receive.
- To control an object whilst moving using body parts or equipment.
- To use equipment to balance an object.

RE – Christianity and Islam
