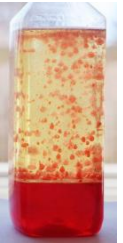
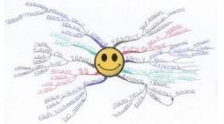


Year 3 Home Learning Tasks Term 1 & 2

Below are tasks to choose from to complete at home over Term 1 and 2 in your scrapbook.

You can complete them in any order and choose to do as many as you wish.

What Can You See? Date:	What are these? What do they represent? Where were they used? Who used them? 
Time to Create! Date:	Create a fortune teller which shows the layers of a volcano. Can you label the different parts of the volcano? 
Time to Create! Date:	Create a lava lamp. Fill a plastic bottle $\frac{1}{4}$ full of water. Add some food colouring into the bottle. Use lava colours if possible. Add double the amount of oil as water. You could even drop a fizzing vitamin tablet into the bottle. Watch what happens and please take lots of pictures to send us on X (formally Twitter).

Date:	The ancient Greeks invented the alarm clock, they thought machines would have artificial intelligence in the future, they created the first system of government, and they invented the yo-yo.
