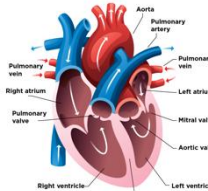


Year 6 Home Learning Tasks Term 1 and 2

Below are tasks to choose from to complete at home over Term 1 and 2.

You can complete them in any order and choose to do as many as you wish.

Knowledge is Key! Date:	Create a fact-file about any of the following topics we're studying: - Islam - The heart and circulatory system - Population around the world - Titanic - Online safety Try and find out some facts we haven't studied in class to amaze the whole class. Alternatively, you could create a digital presentation. Send this to enquiries and we can show this in class. 
The Heart Date:	Draw or create a model of the heart. You could do this with playdoh, clay or just by drawing it. Try and add colour to show where the oxygenated blood and deoxygenated blood goes. We'd love to display them in the classroom. 
Time to Create! Date:	Get creative with the Titanic... using resources you have at home, you could choose to create a model of the Titanic, a lifeboat, a drawing or a painting. Whatever you choose to do, make sure to take a picture or bring it in to show our class! 
Who Will Win? Date:	Create a game! This could be a board game, cards, or a true or false quiz. You can choose to focus on the Titanic, population around the world or the heart and circulatory system. Please bring it in so we can play in class. 
Respect and Happiness Date:	In Term 1 and 2, our key values are respect and happiness. Choose a value and create a mind map with drawings and pictures showing all the ways you show this value. We can share these with Mrs Fisher on Fridays.
