







## Year 2 Home Learning Tasks

<p>Art Gallery</p> <p>Date:</p>	<p>Use the Internet or visit the Library to find out about artists who use the beach to create pieces of art. What do you like or dislike about their work? Try to create your own art inspired by the beach or at the beach if you are able to visit one.</p> 
<p>Fun and games</p> <p>Date:</p>	<p>Make a list of all the games and activities you can do at the seaside. Ask your family and friends what their favourite is. Put your information into a bar chart or tally chart to show the results.</p>
