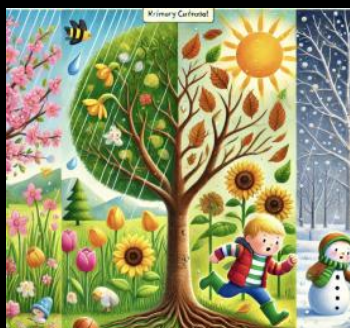


What plants are around us and what different parts do they have?

- To spell words containing each of the 40+ phonemes taught, common exception words and days of the week.
- To combine words to make sentences containing the conjunction and.
- To use joining words and clauses using co-ordinating conjunction 'and'.
- To use the subordinating conjunction 'because'.
- To use the suffix -s and -es.
- To use the prefix un- to change the meaning of verbs and adjectives.
- To use suffixes -ing, -ed and -er on verbs where the root word remains the same.
- To listen and discuss poems, stories and non-fiction texts.

RE – Key Question:

Art – Structure

- To make a sculpture without designing first. .

D&T – Textiles

Geography

- Give examples of human and physical features.
