<p style="text-align: center;">Create a Mayan Information Guide</p> <p>Date:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research the Mayan civilisation and create a fact sheet, PowerPoint, or poster. • Include information on their writing system, number system, gods, food, and buildings. 
<p style="text-align: center;">Mayan Art & Symbols</p> <p>Date:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Design your own Mayan glyphs (symbols) and write a short message using them. • Create a Mayan-inspired mask using household materials. 
<p style="text-align: center;">Design a Safe, Eco-Friendly Home</p> <p>Date:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Draw a plan of a house that saves electricity (e.g., solar panels, wind turbines). • Write an explanation of how it helps the environment. 
<p style="text-align: center;">Designer Challenge</p> <p>Date:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fashion Designer Challenge: design an outfit for a specific purpose (e.g., space travel, a winter holiday, a red-carpet event). Label materials and explain why you chose them. • Chair Design Challenge: Sketch or build a model of a new chair design (using paper, LEGO, or craft materials). Explain who it's for (e.g., a gamer, a child, an elderly person) and why it's comfortable.
