As part of our current work in history around the Tudors, I have arranged to take the class to Gainsborough Old Hall on Friday 21st March. We will leave school at 9am to reach Gainsborough for 10:15am.

In the morning, we will take part in a workshop based on Henry VIII's visit to Gainsborough Old Hall. In the afternoon, we will spend some time exploring the Hall and will return to school for 3:20pm, dependent on traffic.

The cost of the trip will be £13.39 payable via ParentPay. This is to cover the cost of the coach and admission. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning. We know times are financially difficult for our families. If you would like help with the cost of this trip, please do get in touch with us.

The children will need to wear their normal school uniform. Please make sure that they are wrapped up warm with coats, hats and scarves. Although the weather may be warmer by then, the hall itself will still be very cold. Please also make sure that your child has a packed lunch and drink to take with them. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen or they can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch, you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.
