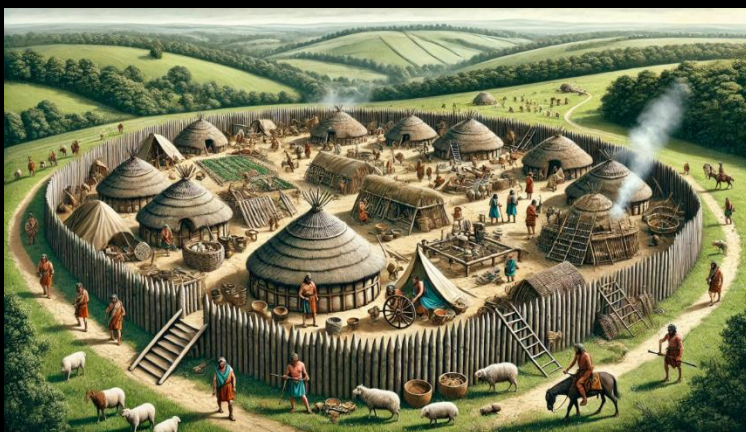


How did life change from the Stone Age to the Iron Age?
