Dear Parents and Carers,

On **Friday 7th March 2025** Year 4 will be going on a trip to **The Lincoln Museum at Lincoln Castle**. This day will be a great experience for the children to carry on their learning about the Anglo-Saxons! We will be visiting the sarcophagus discovered in the remains of an Anglo-Saxon church on the site of Lincoln Castle, handling real and replica artefacts from the Early Medieval period, working in teams to excavate, research and record Early Medieval finds in a mini dig and see how they can help us to understand people of the past.

The total cost of the trip is **£16.83 per child**. FROGs have kindly contributed to the cost of the coach. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. We know times are financially difficult for our families, if you would like help with the cost of this trip, please do get in touch with us in the usual ways.

We will be leaving school at **9:00am** and will return for the usual end of the day collection. The children will need to wear their school uniform and bring a coat as we will be outside for some of the time.

Please also make sure that your child has a packed lunch and drink to take with them. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen or they can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch, you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.
