As you know, at Grimoldby Primary School we are dedicated to supporting your child's learning journey and working together to help them achieve their full potential. Today, we want to highlight the value of short bursts of home learning in developing your child's skills in Maths and Reading.

We understand how busy family life can be, and we know that finding time for home learning can sometimes feel challenging. However, just a few minutes each day can make a significant difference in building confidence and reinforcing the skills your child is learning in school. To support this, we encourage you to use these fantastic resources:

### **Bug Club**

All children are familiar with this from using it with early reading and phonics to accessing texts or spelling games in KS2. It is a highly engaging online reading platform that provides a wide variety of books tailored to your child's reading level. Bug Club helps foster a love for reading while improving comprehension and vocabulary skills.

### **White Rose 1-Minute Maths App**

This app is perfect for quick, focused practice in key Maths areas such as addition, subtraction, and multiplication. The activities are designed to be completed in just a minute, making it easy to fit into even the busiest of schedules. ### **Times Table Rock Stars (TTRS) (KS2)**

All children in KS2 have a **Times Table Rock Stars** (TTRS) account, which they can access either through the app or the website. Regular use of Times Table Rock Stars will help pupils improve their speed and accuracy, building confidence in Maths. In Year 3 and 4, children will be learning their tables up to the 12 times table. Children in Year 5 and Year 6 should continue using TTRS. Even though they may already have a good grasp of their times tables, regular practise helps to further develop speed and accuracy. As they approach more complex Maths questions, being fluent with times tables will give them a strong foundation and boost their confidence in tackling challenging problems.
