Dear Parents and Carers,

To support vulnerable households, a grant is being made available to support those most in need across England with the cost of food. As part of this scheme, Lincolnshire County Council has chosen to make a one-off contribution to support families with providing food. A £100 grant has been allocated to each child who meets this following eligibility criteria:

- Children in receipt of Pupil Premium on 10th November 2024
- Children in receipt of Early Years Pupil Premium on 10th November 2024

Your child has been identified within one of the above eligible categories to receive this grant. To administer this funding to you, we have bought a voucher for you which will be delivered directly to your inbox on Thursday the 5th of December.
