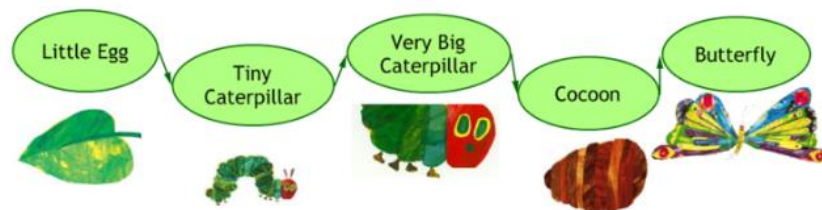
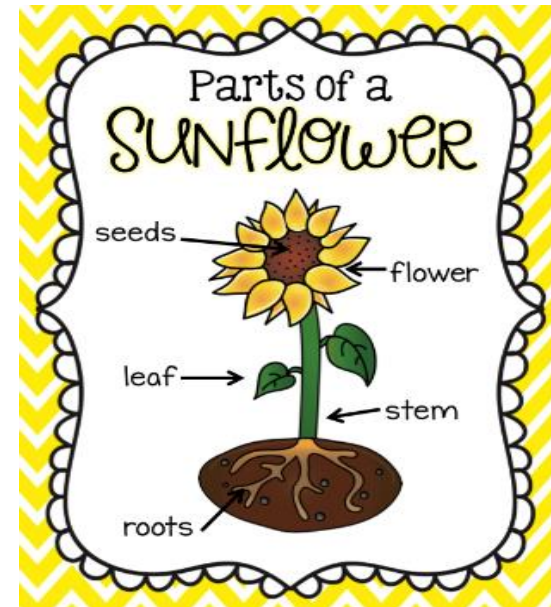


| Key Vocabulary     |  |
|--------------------|--|
| Woods              | Land covered with trees.   |
| Forest             | Larger than the woods and has more habitats for animals.                     |
| Minibeast          | A small creature also known as an insect                                     |
| Nocturnal          | An animal that is asleep in the day and awake at night.                      |
| Diurnal            | An animal that is awake during the day and asleep at night.                  |
| Owls               | A bird of prey. Most Owls are Nocturnal.                                     |
| Bears              | A large mammal.  |
| Caterpillar        | A minibeast.   |
| Butterfly          | A minibeast that a caterpillar turns into.                                   |
| Cocoon (Chrysalis) | The home a caterpillar makes around itself before it turns into a butterfly. |
| Habitat            | The natural home of an animal or plant.                                      |

Woodland animals are animals that live in the wood.

Some woodland animals are nocturnal where they sleep in the day and are awake at night. Owls are nocturnal.

Minibeasts live under a log or stone.
