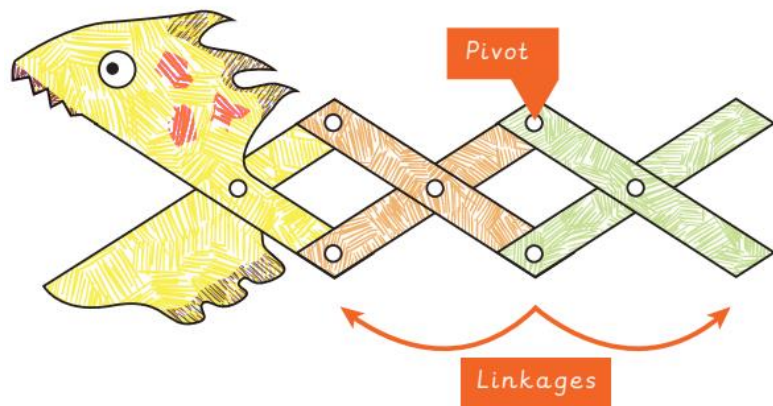


Design and Technology

Input	The energy that is used to start something working.
Linkage	Lengths of material (metal or card) that are joined together by pivots, so that the links can move as part of a mechanism.
Mechanism	A collection of parts that work together to create a movement e.g. a bicycle.
Output	Output is the motion that happens as a result of starting the input.
Pivot	The central point, pin or shaft on which a mechanism turns or swings.
Sculpture	An art form made in three dimensions (3D) that has length, width and height.

Dynamics (volume)		Loud or quiet
Tempo (speed)		Fast or slow
Pulse		The heartbeat of the music. Sometimes called the 'beat.'
Rhythm		Patterns of long and short sounds
Timbre		The quality of the sound e.g. smooth, scratchy, twinkly
