We are excited to inform you about an upcoming trip to **The Deep on Thursday 25th April**. As part of our project, Blue Abyss, this trip will offer our students a unique opportunity to explore the wonders of the ocean and learn about marine life in a hands-on and interactive environment.

Children will be taking part in a workshop focusing on conservation, and the importance of protecting our oceans. Our students will also have the opportunity to observe and learn about a wide array of fascinating marine creatures, including sharks, stingrays, penguins, and other exotic fish.

The total cost of transportation, entry fees, and workshop participation is **£20 per child**. The school have kindly helped contribute to bring the cost of the trip down.
