Dear Parents/carers,

I am pleased to inform you that year 2 will be visiting Mablethorpe beach and the RNLI Station on **WEDNESDAY 11th OCTOBER**. This will give the children valuable first-hand experience of observing physical and human features of the coast and a seaside town as well as learning about the important role of the RNLI.

We shall be going to Mablethorpe for the morning and will return to school in time for lunch. Children will need to wear their school uniform but please make sure they have sensible footwear and a waterproof coat, as we shall still go unless the rain is torrential. It would be advisable to send a spare pair of shoes for when we return to school so that we are not bringing the beach back into our classroom!

The cost of the trip will be **£3.40 payable via ParentPay**. This is to cover the cost of the coach, which we have reduced by sharing the visit with Year 5. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support.
