Dear Parents and Carers,

I am really pleased to share with you your child's annual report for this academic year. Mrs Day is busy in the office sending each report to you via ParentPay and you will receive your child's report by the end of this week. We are trying to help look after our planet by being a paperless school where possible. However, if you would like us to print out a paper copy of your child's report, please do let us know.

Attendance

For parents with children in Reception through to Year 6, we are required by the Department for Education to report on your child's attendance for the academic year. Your child's report will contain their year-to-date attendance from September 2022. At our school, we expect 96% attendance for every child. As you know, we will have already contacted you if your child's attendance falls below this. We currently have an average attendance of 95.3% at Grimoldby Primary School. Good attendance is so important, and we will continue to monitor this up until the 21st July (the last day of term).

Year 6 Reports

Parents with children in Year 6 will receive a teacher assessed result for Reading, Writing, Maths and Science on their child's report. Attached to your child's report, you will find their results from statutory testing in Reading, Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling, and Maths. There will also be end of KS2 comparison information explaining how the attainment of pupils at Grimoldby Primary School compares with attainment nationally in core subjects.

Year 4 Reports

Parents with children in Year 4 will receive their child's result in the Multiplication Tables Check statutory test this year. The test is out of 25 questions. The purpose of the test is to check if children can recall their times tables fluently. Any children who have not yet mastered their times tables will be further supported in Upper KS2.

Year 2 Reports

Parents with children in Year 2 will receive end of KS1 comparison information explaining how the attainment of pupils at Grimoldby Primary School compares with attainment nationally in core subjects. If your child did not achieve a score of 32 or more in the Phonics statutory testing when they were in Year 1, they will have retaken the screening test again this year. You will receive information of the result of the test taken this year with their report. For those pupils not passing this test, we will continue to support their skills in Phonics as they move into KS2.

Year 1 Reports

Parents with children in Year 1 will receive their child's result in Phonics statutory testing this year. Pupils achieving a score of 32 or more have passed the screening test. For those children not passing this test, they will retake it in June 2024.

Reception Reports

Parents with children in Reception will receive a teacher assessment informing you if your child has met the Early Learning Goal for each area of learning. For children still emerging, we will continue to support learning in these areas during the Autumn Term in Year 1.
