## **Dress up day (Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June) and Skegness Aquarium (Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June)**

Dear Parents/Carers,

To launch our new project 'Ocean Adventure' next term, we would like children to come dressed up as a sealife creature or a pirate on the first day back, Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June. Please don't feel you have to buy anything new! Children can make a pirate hat or wear summer clothes and make a mask or headband. We can't wait to see the children all dressed up and showing our school value 'creativity'!

We would also like to take children in Reception to Skegness Aquarium. They will see some of the amazing creatures that live there on a tour of the Aquarium, watch a dive/tank talk and take part in a wet lab session! The visit will take place on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June**.

We will be leaving school at **9.15 am** and returning to school by approximately **3.00pm** for normal collection time at 3.10. Therefore, children will need to arrive at school by the usual time of **8.40am**. The children will need to wear their normal school uniform. Please make sure that they wear appropriate shoes. Please also make sure that your child has a packed lunch and drink to take with them. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen or they can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch, you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.

For the price of coach hire, entry to Skegness Aquarium, and the wet lab session, the trip will cost **£10.33** per child, this is at a reduced rate thanks to FrOGS subsidising the coach hire.

Please make this payment by **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> June** via your ParentPay account. If you have any problems with ParentPay, please speak with Mrs Day in the office. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. We know times are financially difficult for our families. If you would like help with the cost of this trip please do get in touch with us.
