Dear Parents/Carers,

Family History & Rand Farm Park Friday 31st March 2023

We have been focusing on the life cycle of a human this term and discussing how we grow and change. We will also be talking about their family history. Please could you send in photos of your child as a baby, toddler and now. It would be great if you could also provide pictures of their grandparents or older members of their family to support children's understanding of family history. You can upload them to Tapestry if you don't have any physical copies.

To support their learning about our project 'Out of an egg' this term, we would like to take children in Reception to Rand Farm Park. We will be exploring the farm, feeding animals and experiencing the day as a farmer. The visit will take place on **Friday 31st March**.

We will be leaving school at **9.15 am** and returning to school by approximately **3.00pm** for normal collection time at 3.10. Therefore, children will need to arrive at school by the usual time of **8.40am**. The children will need to wear their normal school uniform. Please make sure that your child has a coat, packed lunch and drink to take with them. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen or they can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch, you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.

For the price of coach hire, entry to Rand Farm Park and a special ranger service, the trip will cost **£9.05** per child. We would like to thank FrOGS for a donation towards the cost of the coach. Please make this payment by **Monday 27th March** via your ParentPay account. If you have any problems with ParentPay, please speak with Mrs Day in the office. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. We know times are financially difficult for our families. If you would like help with the cost of this trip please do get in touch with us.
