Dear Parents,

We've had a last-minute opportunity arise on Wednesday 1st March, to take Year 3 to visit the Back to Bear site at Kenwick to bring our Tribal Tales project to life. The visit will provide an opportunity for the children to develop survival skills and understand how different life was in the Stone Age. The children will have the opportunity to handle prehistoric objects, make fires using historical methods and develop hunting skills.

We will be leaving school at **9:00am** and we will be back by **3:15pm**.

Your child will need to come to school wearing warm clothing as we will be outside all day. Layers are recommended along with gloves, a hat and a waterproof jacket. It is important children bring a pair of wellington boots and a spare pair of socks with them in a separate bag.

Children will require a packed lunch with a drink. You can order your child a packed lunch through The Farm Kitchen, or your child can bring a packed lunch of their own. To order a lunch you will need to ring The Farm Kitchen (01529 460821) and it will be delivered to school the day before and stored in our fridge in the hall.

The cost of the visit will be £18.39 per child: this includes the activities, plus the cost of the coach. We realise this is quite last minute, so if you would rather make payment a few weeks down the line, please let Mrs Day know. However, we do ask that payments are made by Tuesday 14th March.

A big thank you to our Friends of Grimoldby School (FrOGS) who are very kindly contributing towards the cost of the coach. Payment on ParentPay acts as consent for your child to go on this visit. Trips are organised to support children's learning and so we would really appreciate your support. We know times are financially difficult for our families so, if you would like help with the cost of this trip, please do get in touch with us.
