Dear Parents and Carers,

On Thursday 9th February 2023, Year 2 will be visiting Sutton on Sea to take part in a wonderful community led project which is being developed by East Lindsey Council. The project is to enhance the Sutton on Sea Pleasure Gardens and Colonnade by having a new mural painted on a triangle wall adjacent to the picnic benches. The children will be met by a local artist, Laura Lilley, who will support the children to paint on the mural itself. The mural wall will be based on Sir Joseph Banks who was an English naturalist, botanist and patron of natural sciences. The children will also take part in a discussion with an officer from the Sir Joseph Banks Society! This really is such an exciting opportunity for our Year 2 children to take part in.

The coach will be leaving school at 9.15am and we aim to be back in school by 12.30. This means that lunches will remain undisturbed, and hot dinners can be ordered as usual. Please ensure your child brings a drink in to school with them.
