Dear Parents and Carers,

As I am sure you are aware, a level three heatwave alert is in place for Lincolnshire until Tuesday 19th July. Although temperatures are predicted to be much higher in the South-East of England, temperatures could still reach as high as 32 degrees Celsius in Grimoldby.

There is clear government guidance on looking after children during heatwaves, and we have completed our own risk assessment to coincide with this guidance. You can find our full risk assessment here:

- The use of ventilation;
- Keeping children hydrated;
- Avoiding vigorous physical activity;
- Encouraging children to wear loose, light-coloured clothing;
- The wearing of sun hats with wide brims;
- The use of sunscreen;
- Providing children with plenty of water.
