Dear Parents and Carers,

I am really pleased to share with you your child's annual report for this academic year. Mrs Day is busy in the office sending each report to you via ParentPay and you will receive your child's report by the end of this week. We are trying to help look after our planet by being a paperless school where possible, however, if you would like us to print out a copy of your child's report, please do let us know.

Year 6 Reports

Parents with children in Year 6 will receive a teacher assessed result for Reading, Writing, Maths and Science on their child's report. Attached to your child's report, you will find their results from statutory testing in Reading, Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling, and Maths. There will also be end of KS2 comparison information explaining how the attainment of pupils at Grimoldby Primary School compares with attainment nationally in core subjects.

Year 2 Reports

Parents with children in Year 2 will receive their child's result in Phonics statutory testing this year. Pupils achieving a score of 32 or more have passed the screening test. For those pupils not passing this test, we will continue to support their skills in Phonics as they move into KS2. There will also be end of KS1 comparison information explaining how the attainment of pupils at Grimoldby Primary School compares with attainment nationally in core subjects.

Year 1 Reports

Parents with children in Year 1 will receive their child's result in Phonics statutory testing this year. Pupils achieving a score of 32 or more have passed the screening test. For those children not passing this test, they will retake it in June 2023.

Reception Reports

Parents with children in Reception will receive a teacher assessment informing you if your child has met the Early Learning Goal for each area of learning. For children still emerging, we will continue to support learning in these areas during the Autumn Term in Year 1.

This has been the first time since 2019 that school has been open throughout the whole year for our pupils. There has also been no statutory testing since 2019. We are immensely proud of all our children's achievements, and we hope you are too. Our children have continued to show determination, unity and resilience. They have shown such enthusiasm for their learning and their end of year report is an opportunity to celebrate their successes.

Thank you so much to all the parents who completed our recent parent survey. It is so important to us to know what we are doing well and if there is anything we can do better. We were so pleased with how positively our parents feel about our school! I would also like to thank you for supporting our Sports Days
