We want as many parents as possible to visit the Art Exhibition, however, we fully appreciate some of our parents work and may not be able to visit the exhibition. If this is the case, please contact us and we will organise an alternative viewing. Pupils in Year 5 and Year 6 who walk home on their own may go and purchase their own work without an adult, but we would love parents to come in and have a look with them if they can.

Our children have been so creative, and we are really looking forward to displaying their hard work at a real exhibition.
